Dear Parent/Caregiver

Today the Premier announced a 7-day statewide lockdown starting at 6.00pm tonight (Tuesday 20 July).

Only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend school.

While tomorrow is a Student Free Day, a skeleton staff will be on site to supervise students of essential workers or vulnerable children who require supervision on site. There will not be a learning program for tomorrow but we will be offering a remote learning program from Thursday. We know that many students have ongoing assignment tasks that form part of their subject learning. If your child needs to attend, we will be here for them.

All students have been asked to take home their school laptops/devices, books and anything else they need to continue their learning from home. All students will use Microsoft Teams to access learning materials, upload tasks and to communicate with their teachers.

More information on learning programs will be provided later this week, as we work our way through the new COVID-19 Directions.

All South Australians are making sacrifices to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. We appreciate that this is a significant undertaking for you and your family. Your child's teacher, our support staff and I are here to support you where we can.
